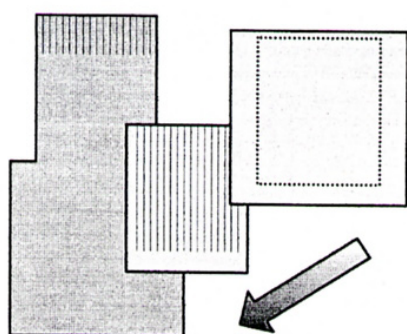
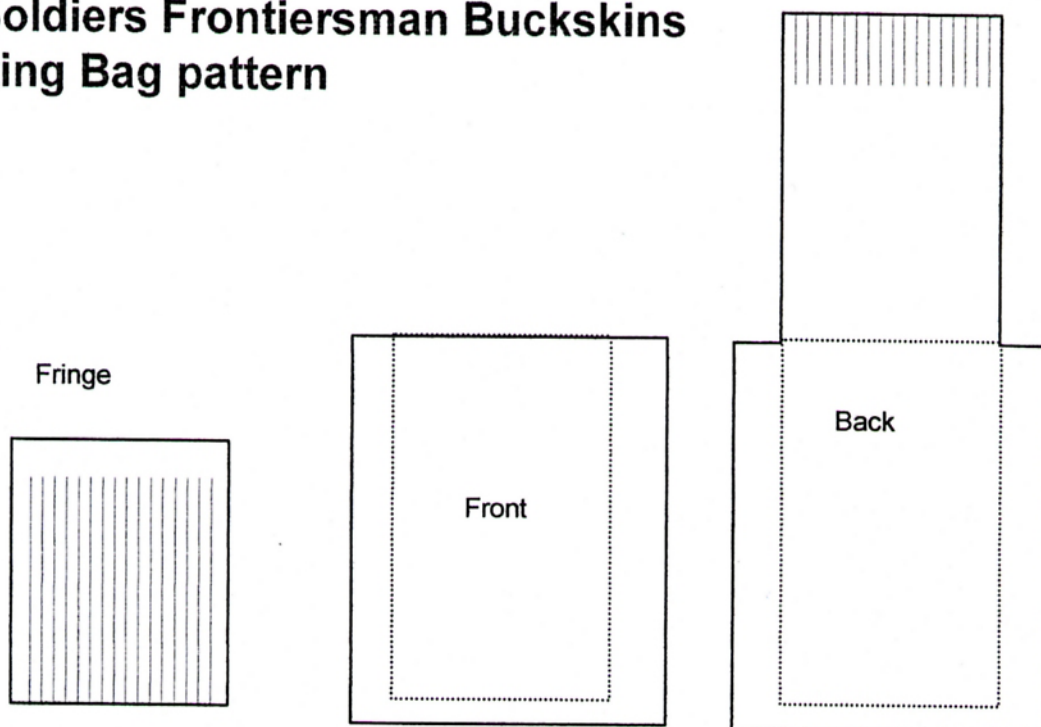
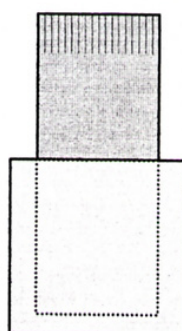


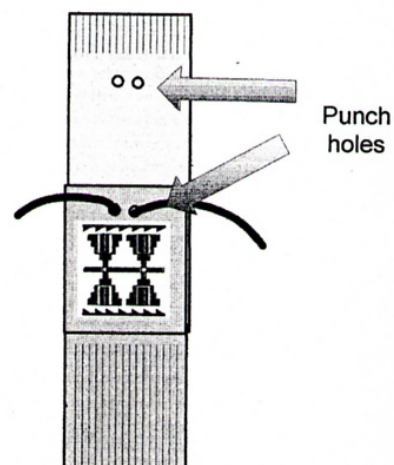
Dog Soldiers Frontiersman Buckskins Shooting Bag pattern



1. Lay the back part down face up and place the fringe and front on top face down.

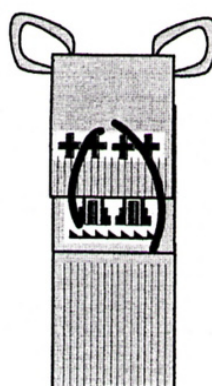
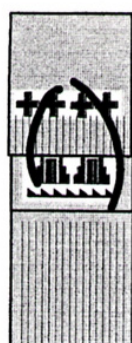


2. Sew the three parts together on the sides and bottom only.



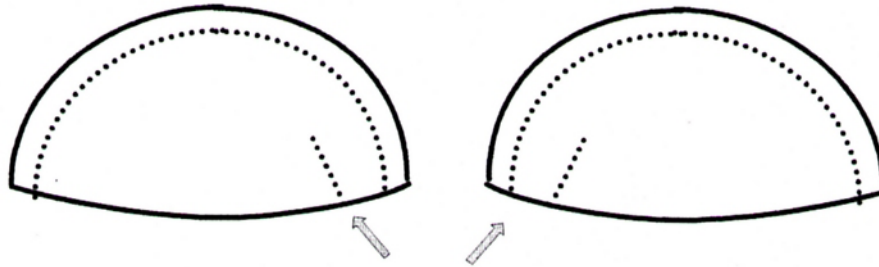
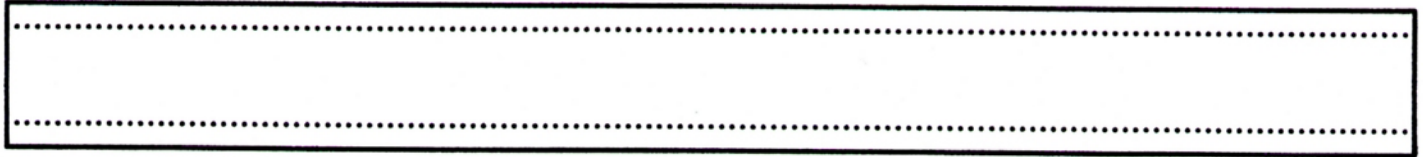
3. Turn the bag right-side out. Punch small holes as shown and thread thin leather lace through them to serve as a tie. You may also glue on the Indian designs provided.

4. Close the top of the bag and thread the leather lace through the top.

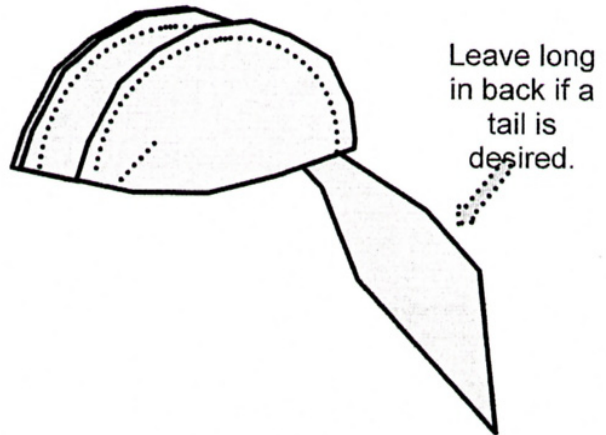
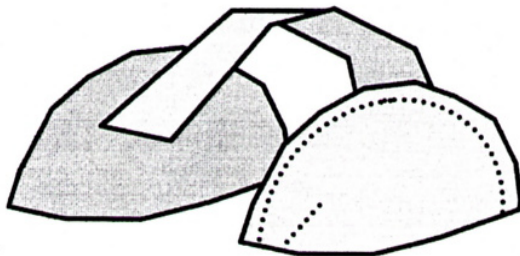


5. Attach two leather loops to hang the bag from a belt or one long strap to carry it over the shoulder.

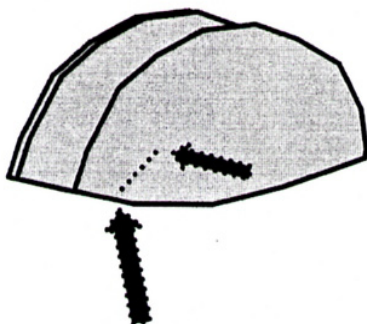


Front of hat

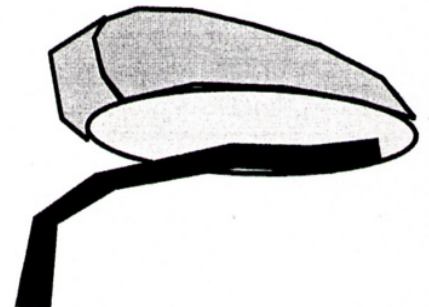


1. (Above) Sew pieces of the hat together inside out as illustrated.

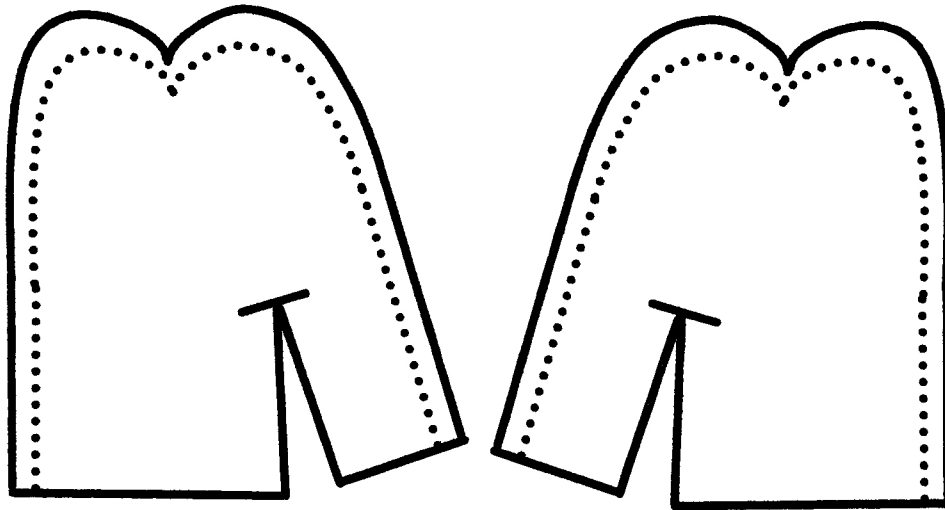
2. (Left) Fit the hat to your figure's head. If it needs to be tightened up, sew darts where shown on each side.



3. (Right) If necessary to improve the fit, sew a leather or elastic hat band inside the hat.



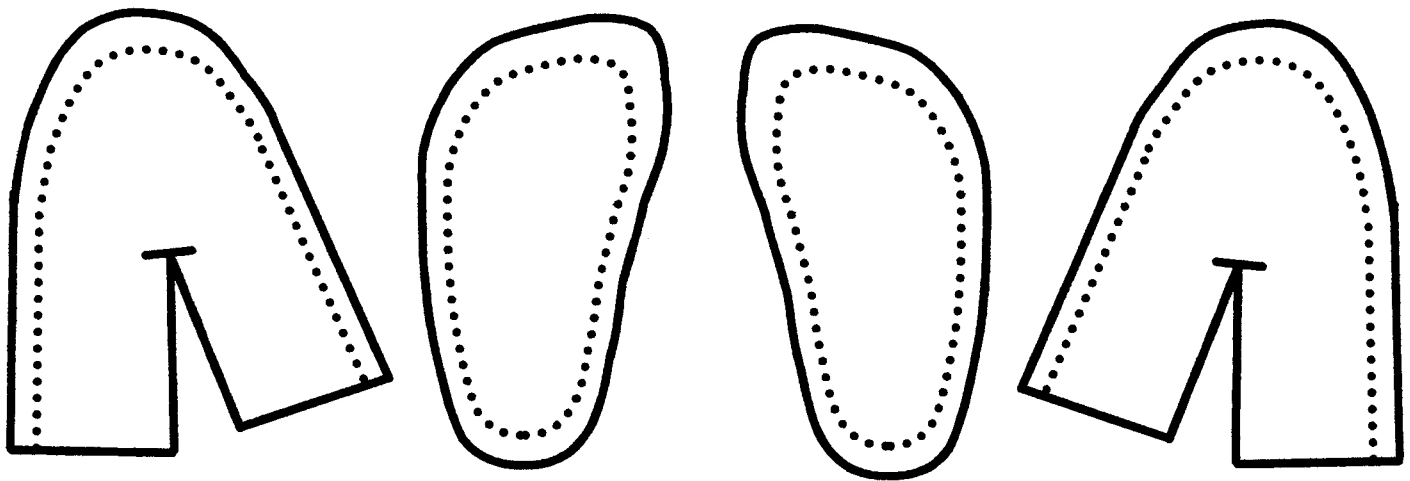
Dog Soldiers Frontiersman High-top Moccasin Pattern



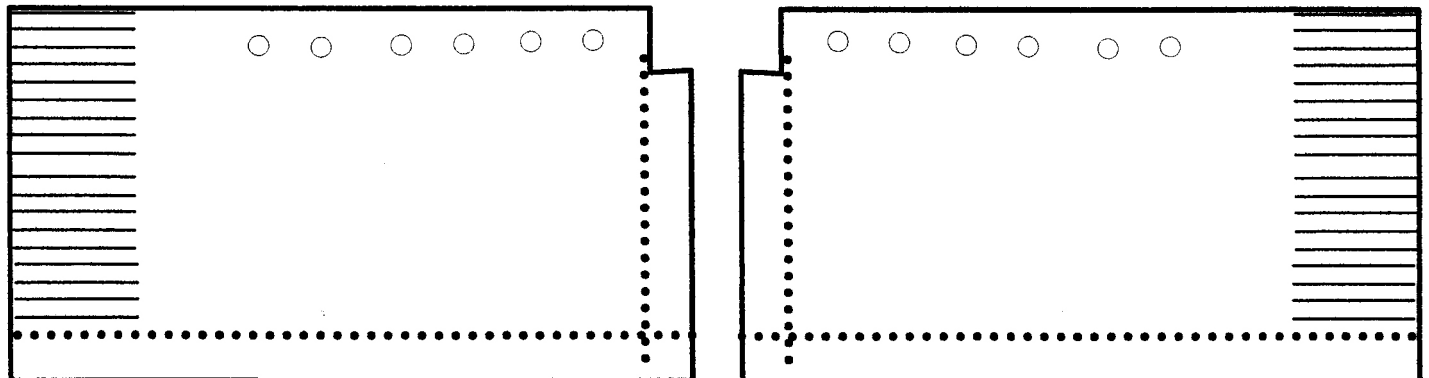
Moccasins for Hasbro-style foot should be folded over and sewn in one piece.

Moccasins for Dragon foot (below) are two-piece. Beginning at the toe, sew the sole to the upper, but leave the heel of the moccasin unsewn until you fit it to your figure's foot.

For Hasbro CC or 21st Century Toys foot.

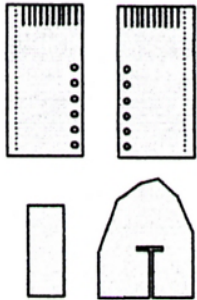

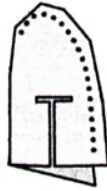

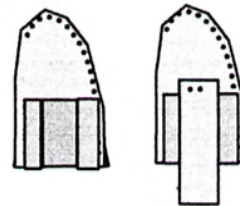
Section 5: Assemble moccasins



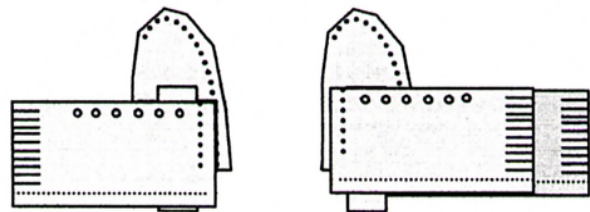
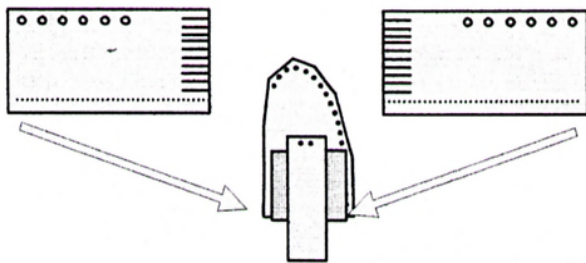
1. Using pattern provided, trace moccasin pieces onto the back of your material and cut them out.



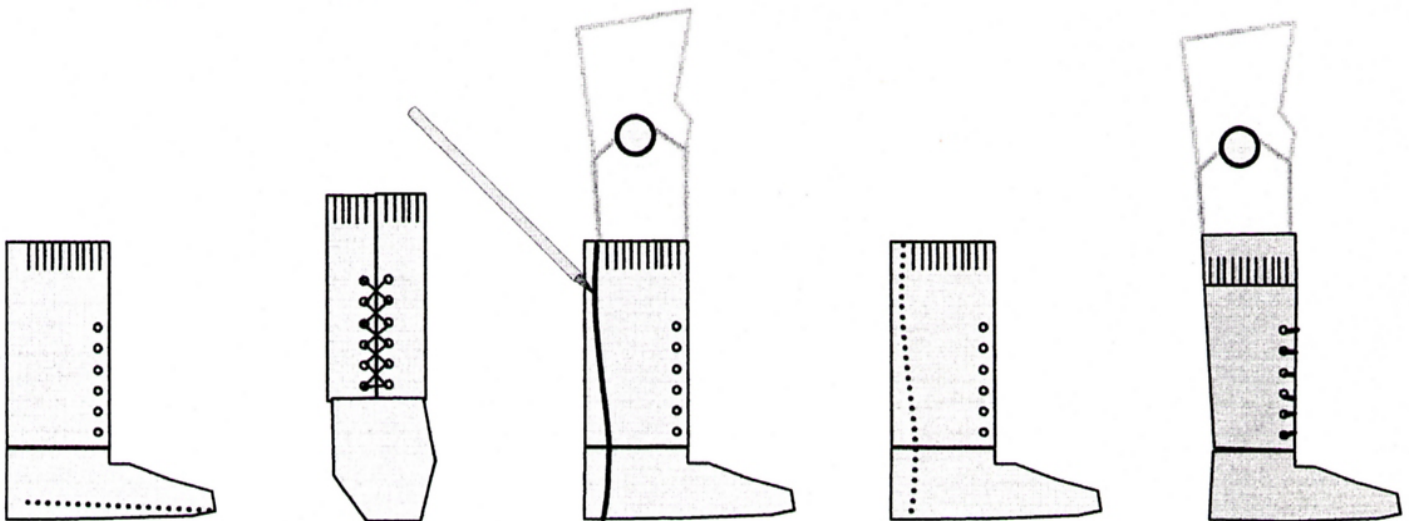
2. Fold the main moccasin piece in half, inside out, and sew the edges together. Do not sew the back of the heel yet.



3. Attach the tongue by folding the moccasin flaps back as shown and gluing or stitching one end of the tongue, face down, in place.



4. Moccasin uppers are sewn to the flaps. See diagram. One way to do this is to attach each upper to the flap, making sure the upper lies across the moccasin as illustrated.



5. With the moccasins inside out, lace them up in the front and fit them to your figure's foot. Mark where the seam should go on the back of the leg for proper fit. Sew on that mark, then turn them inside out and check the fit.
